Block 21 is a three-acre parcel on our Cloverdale Ranch which sits between the eastern bank of the Russian River and the western slope of the Mayacamas mountains. With some of the warmest temperatures in the area, the grapes growing here lend to wines with immense concentration and complexity.

Three generations farming premium wine grapes across five estate ranches for over four decades, the Trione family produce small lot, hand-crafted wines showcasing the best fruit from our vineyards.
